

## Education Program Terms and Information

### Capacity

*Seaward* is U.S. Coast Guard approved to carry 40 passengers within the Bay. This number does not include *Seaward* crew. *Seaward* has 12 passenger berths for overnight programs.

### Rates

#### Bay Explorations 3-hour program:

- \$1,350 for up to 30 passengers (students and adults)
- \$1,550 for up to 40 passengers (students and adults)

Custom education programs and full day programs: Please call for rates.

Overnight programs: Call for quote.

Alternate Pick-up/Drop-off Location: *Seaward* sails from the Bay Model Pier in Sausalito. We are able to pick up and drop off at alternative locations for a \$300 fee plus any additional dockage fee charged by the host marina.

### Scholarships

Call of the Sea's mission is to provide quality education programs to youth of all backgrounds. We offer need-based scholarships and discounted rates to certain groups and individuals. Please call or email for more information.

### Payment

A 20% deposit is required within 14 days of receiving the Sail Contract to confirm a reservation. The balance is required 14 days in advance of the sail date. Payment may be made in the form of cash, credit card (Visa, Master Card, or American Express), money order, cashiers check, or check payable to "Call of the Sea". Credit card payment may be made online or over the phone.


### Weather

*Seaward* sails rain or shine, unless the Captain decides that the inclement weather will compromise vessel or passenger safety. If the Captain decides it is safe to sail and the chartering party wants to cancel, the cancellation terms below apply. If Call of the Sea cancels or there is a mutual decision to cancel, the preferred option is to reschedule. If a suitable date cannot be found, any payment will be refunded less a \$100 administration fee.

### Cancellation

If the sail is cancelled by the charterer 30 days in advance or more, payment will be fully refunded less a \$100 administration fee. If the sail is cancelled by the charterer:

- Less than 30 days from the sail date, payment will be refunded less 20% of the total charter cost. (In other words, the deposit will be retained.)
- Less than 14 days from the sail date, payment will be refunded less 50% of the total charter cost.
- Less than 7 days from the sail date, Call of the Sea will retain 100% of the total charter cost.



## Directions & Parking

*Seaward's* home dock is at the Bay Model Visitor Center, located at 2100 Bridgeway in Sausalito. (Please note that we sail from a different location than our mailing address.) Please use the written directions on our website to help navigate; cellular mapping programs often misdirect and may have errors. There is plenty of free parking at the Bay Model Visitor Center. If you are sailing from an alternate dock, please contact the office if you need directions.

\*If you are running late or having trouble finding the location, you may call the ship's cell phone at (415) 464-7135. Please use the ship's cell number **only** for these purposes. For all other inquiries, call the office at (415) 331-3214.

## Preparing for Your Sail

- Please visit our website, [www.CalloftheSea.org](http://www.CalloftheSea.org), and click on "Educational Youth Sailing" to view your options for the education program. Feel free to call the office if you have any questions about our programs or if you would like to customize your voyage.
- You will receive a call from the onboard Head Educator roughly 2 weeks prior to the sail to confirm the trip as well as exchange pertinent information about the program and passengers. Please have your program option selected and final passenger count ready by this time, as well as any information about individuals who may need special assistance.
- Onboard the vessel, we will separate the students into 3 groups. You are encouraged to make these groups ahead of time.
- *Seaward* always carries enough appropriately sized Type 1 PFDs for every passenger aboard and is U.S. Coast Guard inspected every year. We require students and passengers under 13 years of age to wear a life jacket.
- Please advise students that gum and electronic devices (other than cameras) are not allowed on *Seaward*.
- We want students to get the most out of their short time on the water. Due to the time constraints of our education program, we do not set aside time for lunch or snacks during typical day programs. There is a picnic area at the Bay Model where the group can enjoy a snack or lunch before or after the sail.
- All passengers should wear closed-toe, flat shoes with good traction. (Sneakers are great. No sandals or high heels please!)
- We strongly recommend dressing in warm layers. Be prepared for it to feel significantly colder on the water than on land. If rain is in the forecast, please have all participants bring rain gear.
- Wear sun protection
- There are restrooms outside the Bay Model that may be used before the sail. We recommend having students use the restroom prior to boarding.
- Please plan to arrive at least 15 minutes before the start of your program so we can begin promptly at the scheduled time.
