Call of the Sea voyages are overnight programs in which participants experience nature and build self-confidence through the adventure of sailing a tall ship. Participants form a cohesive team to keep watch, sail the ship, and engage in an interdisciplinary curriculum focused on the bay and coastal maritime environment. The program will begin with tall ship sail training including climbing the rig with a safety harness and learning to safely handle the lines while trimming sails. Youth will join the crew doing ship tasks during the 4 day adventure, from cleaning the decks to anchor watch at night, to helping in the galley.

About the Ship: Matthew Turner is a 132' wooden brigantine, built in Sausalito, CA, and sailing the Bay since 2020. She is an unique educational platform, serving students of all ages in Seamanship, Marine Science, Nautical History and Team Building.
