From marine science exploration to navigating the San Francisco Bay - campers will engage in activities that ignite curiosity, build confidence, and deepen their relationship with the water. Requirements:

- Experience working with students (ages 8-13 preferred)
- Be available for all camp dates and two required training dates, and two required clean-up and debrief dates. Training and clean-up/debrief dates are mandatory but not compensated.

- Ability to work outdoors in various weather conditions
- Passionate about marine science and sustainability
- Positive, energetic, and patient personality
- Team-oriented
- Commitment to safety
- Willingness to work hard and follow instructions
- Excitement and eagerness to learn
- Lifeguard certification preferred
- Spanish language skills preferred

Position Description:

As a Camp Counselor you will help create unforgettable experiences for campers ages 8-13. The Camp Counselors will lead small groups of campers through a fun and educational week focused around marine science, sailing basics, local history, and environmental stewardship. You'll teach hands-on activities and foster a high-energy, positive environment that encourages curiosity and teamwork.

They will work collaboratively with their peer Camp Counselors, Lead Camp Counselor, and Camp Director to organize and deliver activities, troubleshoot any issues, and maintain a fun camp experience. This is an exciting opportunity for those passionate about outdoor education, working with students, marine conservation and sailing.

Camps are week-long day programs from Monday through Friday. Camp counselors start their days at 8 AM and end at 4:30 PM, with a 30-minute unpaid lunch break.

Camp Counselors **MUST** be available and attend all of the camp program weeks AND camp training dates. We encourage those who have full or majority availability to apply.

- Camp Training dates: June 11th - June 12th
- Camp Week One: June 15th - 19th
- Camp Week Two: June 22nd - 26th
- Camp Week Three: July 27th - July 31st
- Camp Week Four: August 3rd - August 7th
- Camp Week Five: August 10th - August 14th
- Camp Cleanup and Debrief: August 17th and 18th

Primary Responsibilities:

- Lead and supervise groups of 6-8 campers
- Teach and facilitate engaging educational programs
- Assist with daily camp operations including enforcing the camp rules and regulations
- Create a positive and energetic camp environment
- Encourage teamwork and cooperation
- Ensure camper safety at all times

This position is contingent upon the successful completion of a Live Scan background check. In addition, new applicants must complete Mandated Reporter Training as a part of their onboarding.
