Milestones and Achievements

In 2025, Call of the Sea celebrated the 20th anniversary of sailing education on our 82' schooner, *Seaward*. Onboard *Seaward* alone, some 25,000 sailors and explorers, young and old, have experienced the joy of exploring on the Pacific Ocean, and life at sea from Northern California to Baja. *Seaward's* journey is just one part of the history of Call of the Sea.

Today, she is joined by the volunteer-built 132' brigantine *Matthew Turner*, which joined our sailing program in 2020. Together these vessels introduce more than 5,000 people each year to sailing, marine conservation and oceanography on the waters of San Francisco Bay and along the California coastline.

Our commitment is to reach as many youth as possible—expanding ocean access and deepening environmental learning focused on Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math (STEAM). With every new sailor and ocean explorer that steps aboard today, we inspire another of tomorrow's ocean advocates.

2025 Milestones:

- Funding was secured for *Seaward's* new engine which will reduce our environmental impact.
- *Matthew Turner* sailed to Monterey Bay, the farthest south yet, surpassing 4,000 lifetime nautical miles!
- Membership in the Commodore's Circle reached 6 donors, each pledging support for three years.

2025 Achievements by the numbers:

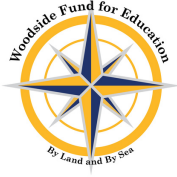
- 53 Title I schools and eligible community groups sailed with scholarship grants

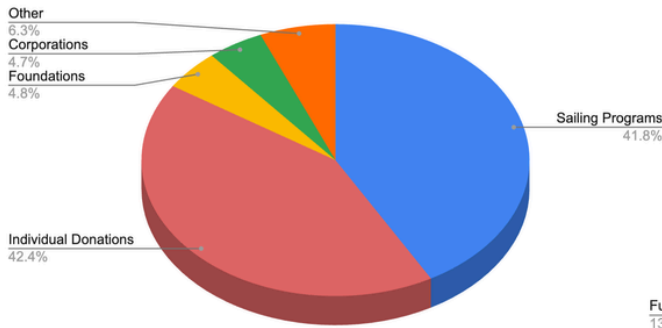

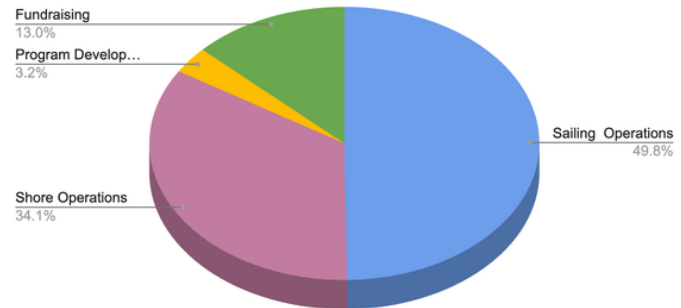

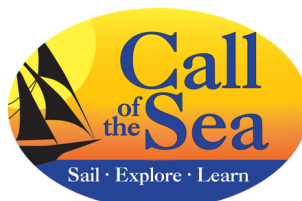
